<p>The elections in Infoland have been delayed by two weeks.</p> <p>[false]</p>	<p>This information is false! Because you believed it, your representative passed the information on to their friends and family. As a result, lots of people lost the chance to vote in an important election, potentially contributing to another candidate winning.</p> <p>-5 pts</p>	<p>This information is false! Because you didn't believe it, your representative went and voted on the correct day, and helped their preferred candidate win the election!</p> <p>+5 pts</p>
<p>The Premier Infotopia, a province of Infoland is thinking of increasing the tax rate, and using the additional money to fund Infoland schools.</p> <p>[true]</p>	<p>This information is true! Because you believed it, your representative was able to give good financial advice to their sister.</p> <p>+5 pts</p>	<p>This information is true! Because you didn't believe it, your representative gave bad financial advice to their sister.</p> <p>-5 pts</p>
<p>Infoland cash is no longer valid. Only InfoCards will be accepted at stores.</p> <p>[false]</p>	<p>This information is false! Because you believed it, your representative made an unnecessary trip to the bank to deposit all of their money, where they were informed that cash is still valid.</p> <p>-5 pts</p>	<p>This information is false! Because you didn't believe it, your representative avoided an unnecessary trip to the bank, and was able to advise their friends and family not to panic.</p> <p>+5 pts</p>
<p>The CoolBar ice cream bar, a popular dessert in Infoland, is contaminated with Infobacteria, an organism that can cause serious infections.</p> <p>[true]</p>	<p>This information is true! Because you believed it, your representative threw out their CoolBars and avoided getting sick.</p> <p>+5 pts</p>	<p>This information is true! Because you didn't believe it, your representative kept their ice cream bars and ate one. They proceeded to get sick, and had to miss work and a day at the beach with their friends.</p> <p>-5 pts</p>
<p>Infoland scientists recommend that people reapply sunscreen every 30 minutes, and that they buy ShadyScreen sunscreen rather than any other type.</p> <p>[false]</p>	<p>This information is false! Infoland scientists recommend that people reapply sunscreen every two hours, and don't have brand recommendations. Because you believed it, your representative ended up spending more on sunscreen than they needed to!</p> <p>-5 pts</p>	<p>This information is false! Because you didn't believe it, your representative bought a more affordable sunscreen, and used less of it – saving money!</p> <p>+5 pts</p>
